Eight boxes of food were packed and delivered to the Cabrini Food Pantry. Fifteen bags of clothes were sorted for the different shelters. Thirty drawstring bags with blankets, winter hat, poncho, socks, water and snacks were filled for Jenna's Blessing Bags which will be distributed to the homeless. Last but not least, many "thank you" cards were designed for our Radnor Firefighters and Police and our soldiers who are deployed!
