From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers

MANNA BAGS and CABRINI UNIVERSITY FOOD CUPBOARD

Throughout the year, you are invited to participate in a variety of food drives, both here in our parish and - I'm sure - from a number of charitable agencies in our area and around the world. In the name of all of those you feed with the support you provide, I thank you for responding to our Lord's call to feed the hungry. The summer is a particularly challenging time for these agencies and I would like to invite you to participate in the two food drives we are sponsoring to help two very different groups of hungry people: some of the parishioners in our sister parish, St. Martin de Porres and some of the students at Cabrini University, right in our neighborhood.

We're all familiar with the gospel accounts of Jesus feeding large crowds; it's one of the few stories of Jesus' public ministry that we find in all four gospels (cf. *Mt* 14:13-21, 15:32-38; *Mk* 6:32-44; *Lk* 9:10-17; *Jn* 6:1-13)! The accounts all begin with Jesus curing the sick or teaching the crowds at length and when it gets late the disciples ask him to send the crowd away so that people can buy themselves some food. Jesus directs the disciples to give the crowd food themselves. The disciples complain that they do not have nearly enough food for so many. Jesus tells them to go and see what they do have. They bring it to him and with it he feeds thousands! It is in this spirit that we share in feeding the hungry today, aware that our efforts are multiplied abundantly with our Lord's help.

Every year, the Nutritional Development Services Office of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia invites all of the parishes throughout the Archdiocese to participate in the MANNA food drive. Each parish is, in turn, allowed to choose which Archdiocesan food center will receive their donations. Due to our close relationship with St. Martin de Porres parish, our sister parish, we select its food cupboard to receive the food we gather through this drive. As we announced at Mass last week, you will find brown shopping bags on the tables at the church entrances this weekend. Please fill one up with non-perishable food and return it to the parish library over the next few weekends. We will deliver the food to St. Martin de Porres food cupboard to help them feed their hungry throughout the summer.



Another place that needs our help is just up the street from us – Cabrini University. We all know how expensive college education has become. And, recent studies have highlighted a surprising need among students in America's colleges and universities: food. It seems that, after the costs for tuition, housing and books are addressed, as many as 20% of the students in four-year colleges and universities throughout the country don't have enough money left over for sufficient food. Cabrini University is one of the local universities with this problem and it has responded by establishing a food cupboard. As you read in our Parish Bulletin a few weeks ago, more and more students there are food insecure and have registered to receive donated items. You will find boxes in our parish library where you can drop off non-perishable food throughout the summer for students at Cabrini University. We will take care of delivering the food to Cabrini. Thank you for your help!

Jesus, many times throughout your life, you fed hungry people and you called others to help. You called the young child with the loaves and fishes to share his gifts. You call each one of us today. Open our eyes to see the needs of others. Open our ears to hear your call to share. Open our hearts to welcome all people to the table of love. Amen.

Parish Nurse Ministry

An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is a portable medical device that analyzes and, when necessary, restores heart rhythm. An AED is the only effective treatment for restoring heart rhythm during a sudden cardiac arrest. AED's are designed for the layperson with step by step instructions. At St. Katharine of Siena, we have 3 AED's on site; they are located in the school cafeteria, the church sacristy and the parish center hallway in front of the Siena Room. 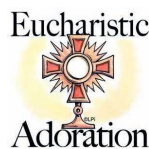
Dear SKS Parishioners,
