Dear Brothers and Sister in Christ,

The Archdiocese for the Military Services was established by Saint John Paul II in 1985 to provide a full range of Catholic pastoral ministries to those in the United States Armed Forces.

The mission of the Archdiocese is to “serve those who serve” by offering pastoral care to Catholics serving in the U.S. Military, enrolled in the nation’s service academies, undergoing treatment at any of the 153 Department of Veteran’s Affairs’ Medical Centers in the United States, Puerto Rico and Guam, working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders, and the families of these populations. The Archdiocese and its priests and deacons are responsible for pastoral service to approximately 1.8 million Catholics. However, unlike a conventional diocese, the Archdiocese has no parishes or parish registries and no weekly collections. It relies solely on the generosity of private donations to support its programs and services.

Last year, Pope Francis told military ordinaries from around the world that “The role of military chaplains is to accompany and support [those in need] on the journey, to be a comforting and brotherly presence for them all.” Your support of the Archdiocese for the Military Services will bring the Gospel, the sacraments and other forms of spiritual support to men and women who serve our country and defend our freedoms, including many individuals and families who hail from our own Greater Philadelphia region.

The collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, which was to be conducted during Lent but was postponed due to the suspension of Masses, will now be conducted in your parish on the weekend of September 26, and 27, 2020. I ask your continued prayers and generous financial support for this important collection.

From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers

THE WINDOWS OF ST. KATHARINE OF SIENA CHURCH Part 7

I'm so glad that our parish school has begun its school year and other parish activities are beginning to resume after a long hiatus due to the coronavirus shut-down – it's hard to believe that it started over six months ago! We continue to monitor the situation very carefully and will do so until the introduction of a safe and effective vaccine allows us to slowly return to normal. In the meantime, we can't just tread water and need to continue to proceed with the essential mission of the Church: living and proclaiming the Gospel!

Allow me to return to our study of our church's beautiful and instructional stained glass windows; they offer us such powerful images of the Gospel message. Two weeks ago, we examined the second window from the altar in the eastern wall of our church that depicts various scenes from the public life of Jesus. This week, I'd like to present to you the next window which depicts Jesus' crucifixion, resurrection and ascension.

This window presents the Paschal Mystery, central to our Christian faith. The right panel depicts the crucifixion of Jesus with his mother Mary and the disciple John – the only disciple who did not abandon Jesus at his hour of greatest need – at the foot of the cross. The cross is green in color, representing the new life that Jesus offers through his death. Above Jesus, the initials "INRI" speak of his kingship: they are the first letters of the Latin inscription "Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudeorum" (Jesus of Nazareth King of the Jews) that was placed on his cross (cf. *Matthew* 27:37). It was Roman custom to write the offense of a person condemned to death by crucifixion and place it on the cross as a deterrent to passers-by. The synoptic gospels (*Matthew*, *Mark* and *Luke*) simply report that this inscription was placed on Jesus' cross. In the *Gospel of John*, however, this inscription is the cause for a lively argument between the Jewish chief priests and Pontius Pilate. They protested that it should read "He said, 'I am the King of Jews.'" Ironically, it appears that Pilate was more aware of who Jesus was than the Jewish leaders; his response to them was, "What I have written, I have written" (cf. *Jn* 19:19-22).

The bottom of the first panel of this window displays an altar with bread and wine on it. This is an allusion to the Eucharistic Celebration in which we re-present not only the Last Supper but also our Lord's sacrifice on the cross. The grated window alludes to his descent into the netherworld after his death to raise the faithful dead to everlasting life. Notice the empty tomb on the right. Jesus rises from the tomb with a glorified body in the center panel as the sun rises behind him on Easter Sunday. The burial cloth is draped over the stone that no longer seals the tomb.

In the left panel, Christ ascends into heaven as the disciples raise their hands in joy and jubilation. They - and the trumpets - are a reference to *Psalm* 47:6: "God mounts his throne amid shouts of joy; the Lord amid trumpet blasts." The stars recall *Psalm* 148:3: "Praise him, sun and moon; praise him all shining stars."

As you study this window, don't miss the colorful band that passes through the last two panels. As I mentioned several weeks ago, this band, which emanates from the burning bush at the bottom of the eastern window nearest the altar and swirls through many of the eastern windows, represents God's saving action down through the ages – from Old Testament times to New Testament times and even until today; you will see it again in the last window of the eastern wall.

The last window on the eastern wall of our church presents Pentecost, the Assumption of Mary and the Church today. Once again, the window is filled with powerful symbolism; I'll explain it all in upcoming weeks – see you then!
