**THE WINDOWS OF
ST. KATHARINE OF SIENA CHURCH
Part 8**

I hope you enjoyed this past week's introduction to fall with its clear, sunny skies and crisp temperatures! The clear skies and brilliant sunrises and sunsets have made our stained glass windows shine even more beautifully in the early morning and before sunset. As we study the last of the large stained glass windows in the nave of the church, you will see, once again, how they offer us such powerful images of the Gospel message down the ages even until today. God's great work of creation and re-creation has occurred in history and we're currently making history for future generations. In the midst of this coronavirus pandemic, we are assured that God's saving work continues in our midst and we benefit from reflecting on it every day. Let's examine this last window.

The last nave window presents Pentecost, Mary's Assumption and the Church today. The right panel shows the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove hovering over the apostles hiding behind walls "for fear of the Jews" (John 20:19). They are surrounded by fire. The Acts of the Apostles reports that these tongues of fire "parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim" (Acts 2:3-4). The billowing curtain is evocative of the account in the Acts of the Apostles that states "there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind" (Acts 2:2).

The center panel depicts Mary's assumption into heaven. Notice the tomb at her feet as well as the roses (symbolic of Mary) and the stars (which speak of her being assumed into heaven) that surround her. On the bottom of the panel the Ark of the Covenant provides an allegorical reference to Mary as the ark of the new covenant; after all, she is the bearer of God's Son.

The left panel depicts the Church of today. The green cross represents the living Church flowing from the side of Christ (cf. John 19:34). The laurel wreath above the cross symbolizes Christ's victory over death. The Church holds the keys to the kingdom and the priest celebrating Mass presents the primary purpose of the Church – to lead its people in worship of the one, true God. The red heart behind the priest speaks of Christ's love for his Church which is present in the people gathered below the altar. The anchor-cross with four stars is a symbol of hope found often in the catacombs of the early Church. The anchor signifies the Church, often depicted as a ship sailing through the storms of time, and the stars symbolize the four gospels. Notice the book, bearing the Greek letters chi and rho, the first two Greek letters of Χριστός - "Christ". You will recall that "Christ" is Greek for "Messiah," the anointed one. This ancient symbol of Christ emphasizes that Jesus, the Word-made-flesh, remains in the Church, the Body of Christ.

As you study this window, don't miss the colorful band that passes through all three panels and ends behind the priest celebrating the Eucharist. As I have mentioned earlier, this band, which emanates from the burning bush at the bottom of the eastern window nearest the altar and swirls through many of the eastern windows, represents God's saving action through his Son, Jesus, down through the ages – from Old Testament times to New Testament times and even until today; it is most clearly present in the Eucharistic celebration.

Before moving to the stained glass windows in the church transepts, I would like to offer some reflections on the large window above the church's choir loft. With the pipes from our old organ removed, it's even more prominent than before. It represents the Lord's Second Coming and, like the other windows we have studied so far, is filled with powerful symbolism. I'll explain it all in upcoming weeks – see you then!

The stained glass window is a large, multi-paned work of art, likely from a Gothic or Romanesque church. It is divided into 12 panels, arranged in a 4x3 grid. The central column (panels 5, 6, 7, 8) depicts the life of the Virgin Mary and the infant Jesus: the Annunciation (top), the Nativity (second), the Circumcision (third), and the Epiphany (bottom). The left column (panels 1, 2, 3, 4) shows the Baptism of Christ (top), the Marriage at Cana (second), the Last Supper (third), and the Descent into Hell (bottom). The right column (panels 9, 10, 11, 12) illustrates the Resurrection (top), the Ascension (second), the Pentecost (third), and the Last Judgment (bottom). The artwork is characterized by its vibrant colors, bold outlines, and intricate patterns, typical of medieval stained glass.
