From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers



In case you haven't already heard, I'm excited to announce that our school is a 2020 recipient of the National Blue Ribbon Schools award! On 24 September 2020, we were among just 367 schools in the nation and one of 14 schools from the entire state of Pennsylvania to be recognized as an Exemplary High Performing National Blue Ribbon School for 2020 by U. S. Secretary of Education Betsy DeVos. This is a tremendous honor and a national recognition of the excellence of our school. Only two other schools in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia – Mother of Divine Providence Regional Catholic School in Wallingford and St. Patrick School in Malvern – received the award this year. Since the program's inception in 1982, a total of 39 Catholic schools in the Archdiocese have been recognized with Blue Ribbon status.

Terrel H. Bell, the national Secretary of Education under President Ronald Reagan, initiated the Blue Ribbon Schools program in 1982 to bring public attention to the best schools in the United States and to facilitate communication and sharing of best practices within and among schools. These schools serve as examples for other schools throughout the nation and details of their achievements are shared in the U.S. Department of Education's website. Each National Blue Ribbon School selected receives a plaque and flag to signify its exemplary status. In identifying outstanding schools annually across the entire country, the program celebrates school excellence by affirming the hard work of teachers, students, families and communities in creating a safe and welcoming school where a love of learning is promoted, valued and celebrated.

I want to thank our outstanding principal, Mr. Bud Tosti, along with our excellent teachers and staff who, thanks to their work throughout the years, have enabled us to become such a strong school. I also want to specifically thank Adria Crowley and David Heacock, two of our teachers who spearheaded the application process for the National Blue Ribbon Schools Program. This award is a credit to our entire community as well as all of our parents, students, volunteers and many supporters. It is the first time we have applied for this designation and we are so happy that the U.S. Department of Education now acknowledges what we have known all along: St. Katharine of Siena School is among the top schools in the nation. We are humbled, and at the same time, extremely proud. Please join us in celebrating this fantastic accomplishment!

Allow me to provide you with the Mission Statement for our school; I think it offers an excellent overview of what our school strives to be:

Saint Katharine of Siena School (SKS), established in 1916 and guided by the teachings of Jesus Christ, is a Catholic community educating students in kindergarten through eighth grade. SKS is committed to academic excellence through a rigorous learning environment that seeks to develop the whole child, integrating Catholic values of service and respect for all of God's people. SKS fosters the spiritual, moral, intellectual, emotional, and physical growth of its students in a spirit of dedication, freedom, and love based on the message of the Gospel. Each student is a child of God. Students are encouraged to become responsible leaders. They are supported as they grow in wisdom, age, and grace to assume their roles as informed, responsible, members of our Church and citizens of our country and our world.

The administration, faculty, and staff of SKS encourage each student to become Christ-centered by learning and following His commandments. They believe the school community is an extension of the Church. As such, it is united through the Eucharist, liturgical celebrations, daily prayer, and in service to others.

Cabrini University Food Cupboard

Many of the Cabrini University students are returning this month and the University is looking to restock their food pantry. The Cabrini Cupboard is for any student who is having difficulty affording groceries or accessing sufficient food to eat every day and feels that it might affect their performance in the classroom. Covid-19 has left many families facing a greater financial strain and has exacerbated food insecurity. With that in mind, parishioners at St. Katharine's have been donating to the Cabrini Cupboard to keep students focused on learning and not worrying about their next meal.

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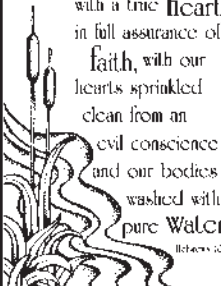
