From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers

Solemnity of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

“And be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly. ...And whatever you do, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the Lord, giving thanks to God the Father through him” (*Colossians 3:15ff*).
