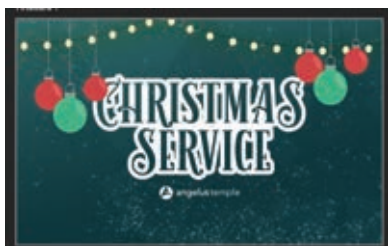

THE WINDOWS OF ST. KATHARINE OF SIENA CHURCH

PART 9

"I saw a large white throne...then another scroll was opened, the Book of Life."

(The *Book of Revelation* 20:11a, 12b)

As we continue the Season of Advent, the beginning of the Liturgical Year and a time when we focus on the two comings of the Lord - in Bethlehem on Christmas Day and at the end of time when he will come to judge the living and the dead - this is a good time for us to examine and reflect on the large window above our church's choir loft which represents the final judgment as depicted in the *Book of Revelation*, the last book of the Bible. Like the rest of our beautiful stained glass windows, it is full of symbolism. The splendid azure color of the window is evocative of the heavens. In *Revelation* 21:1, we read: "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth." In the center of the window, we find a throne set upon a ruby and emerald base. The precious stones recall the description of the new and heavenly Jerusalem found in *Revelation*: "Around the throne was a halo as brilliant as an emerald" (4:3). And, the triangular base upon which the throne sits speaks of the Trinity at work. The Book of Life rests on the seat of the throne. On this throne, Christ will judge the living and the dead. As we read in *Revelation* 20:15: "anyone whose name was not found written in the Book of Life was thrown into the pool of fire." On the other hand, to those whose names are written in the Book of Life, we hear our Lord proclaim: "Behold, God's dwelling is with the human race. He will dwell with them and they will be his people. ...and there will be no more death or mourning, wailing or pain, for the old order has passed away" (*Rv.* 21:3b, 4b).

The Holy Spirit streaks above the throne, surrounded by a red, scarf-like band that portrays the speed of his coming. A curved red and cyan line snakes below the Holy Spirit representing the passage of time into eternity. The stars which follow the line of time are the saints who "lead many to justice" and who "shall be like the stars forever" (*Daniel* 12:3). The seven flaming torches burning around the throne are the "seven spirits of God" (*Rv.* 4:5). The inscription, "Come, Lord Jesus!" is a liturgical prayer from the early Church in expectation of the second coming of the Lord. These are the last words of sacred scripture and conclude the *Book of Revelation*.

As we prepare to celebrate Christmas, which recalls the birth of Jesus, we do well to remember why he came: to lead us all back to his heavenly Father. He invites us to follow him but we need to accept his invitation and follow in his ways. At the end of time, our risen Lord will return in glory and we want to be sure to be included in the Book of Life so that he will call out our name and welcome us to his side. "Come, Lord Jesus!"
