Dear Friends in Christ,

A blessed New Year of 2021 and the *Year of Saint Joseph*, Patron of the Universal Church. As we prepare to celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, we can reflect upon the Gospel of St. Luke, noting that, “his father and his mother marveled at what was said about him” (Lk 2:23), in particular at what Simeon said in his canticle to God, when he referred to Jesus as the “salvation which you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel” and as a “sign that is spoken against” (cf Lk 2:30-34). *APOSTOLIC EXHORTATION, REDEMPTORIS CUSTOS, JOHN PAUL II, 1989*

This letter brings our attention to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, observed on February 2nd, celebrating Christ as the *Light of the World* and World Day of Consecrated Life, as Saint John Paul II perceived consecrated person to be “lights for the world,” bringing Christ to others. In his encyclical, *Lumen Fidei*, Pope Francis wrote: “Those who have opened their hearts to God’s love, heard his voice and received his light cannot keep this gift to themselves.”

Our world today has need for bright and shining lights; true witnesses of dedicated and committed lives that serve the Church and the local civic communities. We need also weapons of holiness, the sacraments and prayer. Pope Francis, in his Apostolic Exhortation, *Gaudete et exultate*, says: “Holiness is also parrhesia: it is boldness, an impulse to evangelize and to leave a mark in this world. To allow us to do this, Jesus himself comes and tells us once more, serenely yet firmly, “Do not be afraid” (Mk 6:50). These words enable us to go forth and serve with the same courage that the Holy Spirit stirred up in the Apostles, impelling them to proclaim Jesus Christ. How often are we tempted to keep close to the shore! Yet the Lord calls us to put out into the deep and let down our nets (Lk 5:4). He bids us to spend our lives in his service...to put all our charisms at the service of others.” We have experienced this gift of service from the many consecrated men and women who serve in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

This year, we will observe World Day of Consecrated Life on Sunday, February 7, 2021 at the Cathedral Basilica of Sts. Peter and Paul with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass at 11:00 am. I invite all consecrated men and women to participate. Following the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, there will be a light reception in Drexel Hall. Please join us in celebrating this special day.

May the gift of vocations to the Consecrated Life continue to call us forth in mission to preach the Gospel through word and deed. May Saint Joseph, our Guardian and Protector, intercede for each of us to be righteous and just, and lights for all whom we meet and serve as we celebrate World Day of Consecrated Life. A Blessed Feast of the Presentation of the Lord.

Spiritual Adoption Program

Everyone loves the beauty and innocence of a baby. As an expression of that love, our parish Respect Life Committee is sponsoring a spiritual adoption program for young and old. Our parish family will soon have the opportunity to “spiritually adopt” a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all babies make it to birth. Many parents tragically experience the loss of a child to miscarriage or premature birth. And more than 3,000 babies lose their lives to abortion each day. These are the babies you are being asked to “adopt” simply by praying for him or her each day. You may “adopt” a child individually or as a family. Name cards will be at the church doors. We invite you to name the child for whom you will be praying, which will remind you that, although you may never meet the child in this life, you truly are praying for a specific child who needs your prayers. Post the name card in a prominent place in your house to remind you to pray for him/her. Then, watch our Parish Bulletin for monthly reports describing “your baby’s” development. In October, we will celebrate the “births” of our spiritually adopted babies. There are millions of unborn babies desperately in need of your prayers. Won’t you please “spiritually adopt” one and share the love for life that God has given you?

Parish Nurse Ministry

An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is a portable medical device that analyzes and, when necessary, restores heart rhythm. An AED is the only effective treatment for restoring heart rhythm during a sudden cardiac arrest. AED’s are designed for the layperson with step by step instructions. We have 3 AED’s on site; they are located in the school cafeteria, the church sacristy and the parish center hallway in front of the Siena Room. Low-Gluten Hosts Available at Mass

As more people become aware of celiac disease, which, according to a recent report in the World of Gastroenterology, “now affects one in 100 people in Europe and North America,” low-gluten hosts (i.e., with a gluten content of 0.01 percent) are available at Mass for those who request them.
