Instructions for making casseroles for Mercy Hospice. Please take a copy home and refer to these recipes in the future.

- 1. Take one foil pan with lid for each casserole you will be making.
- 2. Label the end of the pan with the name of the recipe, before you fill with any ingredients. Masking tape does not stick to the hot pan very well.
- 3. Follow the recipe as exactly as possible.
- 4. After preparing the recipe, **freeze it at home** before bringing to church.
- Bring the FROZEN casserole any day and drop off at the Mercy Hospice Door located directly across from the church entrance/exit (adjacent to the Parish Center). Inside is a freezer labeled Casseroles for Mercy Hospice.
- 6. Collect a new foil pan across from the freezer.
