## THE SEASON OF ADVENT BEGINS

**“NOTHING COMPARES TO BEING THERE!”**



All of us know instinctively that nothing compares to “being there” in person. Whether it’s sitting down to have a heart-to-heart conversation, attending a friend’s wedding, comforting a family member or close friend while he/she is grieving or watching your child take his/her first steps, we all know that being physically present makes all the difference; nothing compares to being there!

The same is true with God and, as we begin the Season of Advent once again, we eagerly anticipate our God coming to “be there” in person – in the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus came to save us in the flesh; that’s what we celebrate every Christmas! And, at every Mass, Jesus encounters us in person. Although the coronavirus pandemic caused many of us to suspend this personal encounter – for good reason – now is the time to return in person to join with our fellow parishioners in encountering God who reveals himself to us in the sacred Word and offers himself to us in the Holy Body and Blood of his Son, Jesus Christ. And so, our parish joins with every parish in our archdiocese in announcing “Nothing Compares to Being There!”

As you know, every Eucharistic Celebration is a participation in the Last Supper and the Crucifixion and Resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ. We are privileged to join in this once-and-for-all sacrifice for our salvation. It is a sacred meal and has some aspects that are very similar to any meal that we share when we gather as extended family or with friends to celebrate Thanksgiving or Christmas or someone’s birthday or wedding anniversary. Before sitting down for dinner, we spend some time catching up with each other, sharing our stories and enjoying each other’s company. Then, we gather at table to feast. In the same way, the Eucharistic Celebration begins with us spending some time with God as he speaks to us through Sacred Scripture – God’s own revealed Word. We hear stories of God’s family down through Salvation History and we respond with the Responsorial Psalm, Gospel Acclamation and General Intercessions. And then, the priest, acting in the person of Jesus Christ, offers us the most precious feast we can imagine – the Sacred Body and Blood of our Lord in Holy Communion.

Bishop Robert Barron, director of the Word on Fire, offers two wonderful video reflections on the Eucharist, explaining various aspects of this important celebration and the real presence of our Lord. Hover your iPhone or iPad over these QR codes to view them or type in the URL code for each reflection. In the first one, Bishop Barron reminds us that the Mass is the “source and summit of our faith” and the most intense moment, this side of heaven, for us to encounter God. He comments on the two moments in the Mass – the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist – explaining them with his usual clarity.

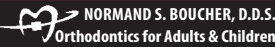
