From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers



As we begin Catholic Schools Week with the theme, “Catholic Schools: Faith. Excellence. Service,” I want to call your attention to the logo that the National Catholic Education Association is providing for this year. In presenting this logo, the NCEA offers this explanation:

The logo emphasizes that the Catholic school, like the Catholic Church, is not a building or an institution, but it is the people. As the people of God, we are called to work together to bring the Kingdom of God to earth and raise up the next generation to do the same. The image of teachers and students forming the foundation of the school shows that they are active people of faith who serve others and God. Catholic schools have a specific purpose to form students to be good citizens of the world, love God and neighbor and enrich society with the leaven of the gospel and by example of faith. As communities of faith, Catholic schools instill in students their destiny to become saints. Academic excellence is the hallmark of Catholic education intentionally directed to the growth of the whole person – mind, body and spirit. Finally, service is fundamental to Catholic education and the core of Catholic discipleship. Service is intended to help form people who are not only witnesses to Catholic social teaching, but also active participants through social learning.

Yes, our Church and our school are not, first and foremost, buildings, but people. This year, I would like to draw your attention to one of the most important people in our school: Bud Tosti. He has served us for 20 years, first as a teacher and then, for the past 17 years, as our beloved principal. Over those years, he has impressed, edified and inspired us all with his tireless enthusiasm, his genuine care for each of our students and staff members and his dogged determination to ensure that our school is the best it can be; excellence is his goal every day. He is strong in his faith and encourages everyone to grow in their faith in a wide variety of ways. He clearly embodies the theme of this year’s Catholic Schools Week and we have been so fortunate to have him as our school principal.

As you may have already learned, Bud will be retiring this June. He had approached me a few years ago to explore his retirement. He is just a few months younger than I am so I had anticipated it but was not eager for it to happen. And, we were just establishing the Board of Limited Jurisdiction, so he agreed to stay on for another year. Then, we were applying for the National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence Award, as well as the renewal of our Middle States Accreditation, so he agreed to stay on for yet another year. Then, COVID-19 arrived and he agreed to stay one more year. Finally, in September, he submitted his letter of retirement. We will celebrate Bud’s legacy on 22 April with a special event organized by a special committee made up of a host of his fans and devotees. You’ll want to mark your calendars for *Bud’s Last Call!*

Yes, teaching our children about faith, excellence and service is essential for the continued mission of our parish and, indeed, the entire Church, and we are all indebted to such dedicated people as Bud who ensure that our students grow in their faith, excel in their work as students and recognize the essential aspect of service as members of God's family and of our world. As we celebrate *Catholic Schools Week*, let's thank God for our strong and vibrant school and rededicate ourselves – each of us – to teaching our children the wondrous ways of our faith! May we all strive to live in active service of Jesus and his mission as we join together with the rest of the Catholic schools throughout our country in celebrating *Catholic Schools Week*.

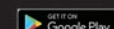
