From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

"After all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (*Lk* 3:21-22). On this, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, we hear God the Father declare that Jesus, the son of Mary is, indeed, His Son as well. And, He is well pleased with him. Immediately after his baptism, Jesus defies Satan's temptations and begins his public ministry, declaring "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel!" (*Mk* 1:15)

At our baptism, we, too, become sons and daughters of God and God is well pleased with us. After the child is baptized, the priest instructs the faithful: "Dearly beloved, this child has been reborn in baptism. He is now called a child of God, for so indeed he is." The priest also declares to the newly baptized: "God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has freed you from sin, given you a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and welcomed you into his holy people." At baptism, our sins are removed and we are given the power to defy Satan's temptations through the help of the Holy Spirit. We also become members of the Church, which is called to continue the work Jesus began and bring God's kingdom to fulfillment. What a wonderful privilege it is!

The Second Vatican Council has recalled us all to the earliest times of the Church when everyone who was baptized was called to share in the mission of the Church. In one of the most significant documents that resulted from Vatican II, the Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, the council Fathers spoke very clearly of the variety of roles that the priests, religious and laity play in the Church. After outlining the hierarchical structure of the Church, with the pope as successor of Peter surrounded by his fellow bishops who are assisted by priests and deacons and religious, this document states that "[t]he apostolate of the laity is a sharing in the salvific mission of the Church. Through Baptism and Confirmation all are appointed to this apostolate by the Lord himself" (§33).

The *Dogmatic Constitution on the Church* further explains that "pastors also know that they themselves were not meant by Christ to shoulder alone the entire saving mission of the Church toward the world. On the contrary, they understand that it is their noble duty so to shepherd the faithful and recognize their service and charismatic gifts that all according to their proper roles may cooperate in this common undertaking with one heart" (§30).

By our baptism, all Catholics are called to share in this sacred mission. By ordination, the pastor is called to lead and to encourage his parishioners to share in this mission, using their talents and abilities for the good of the larger community. What great work could be accomplished if everyone would respond! In this Archdiocese, there are approximately 1.3 million baptized lay Catholics. In our parish alone, there are just over 7,600 registered Catholics. Over the past three years, under the strong leadership of Laura Kerr, a parishioner with a true passion for her faith, and the persistence of our Evangelization Team, our evangelization initiative has helped more than 50 of our parishioners become aware of their baptismal call to become missionary disciples. But, what if every one of the baptized were to respond to their baptismal call! We are all the Church, and the Church can only do as much as each one of us contributes! With the active involvement of more parishioners, we can make our parish an even better place for us to fulfill our baptismal call to continue the work Jesus began and bring God's kingdom to fulfillment throughout the year! Let us all reflect on the power of our baptismal call and respond with joy, for we are, indeed, privileged to be part of God's family, his sons and daughters with whom he is well pleased!
