From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers

OUR SCHOOL TO HAVE A NEW PRINCIPAL

As you may already know, we have been hard at work searching for a new principal to succeed Bud Tosti, who has been our outstanding principal for the past 17 years. We are all very grateful to Bud for his exemplary servant leadership of our school which received the Blue Ribbon School of Excellence award under his guidance just two years ago. Anyone who knows Bud recognizes that he has given himself entirely to serve our school. As a result of his tireless efforts, our school is a vibrant, faith filled community where our school parents, teachers and staff work selflessly to ensure that our children are well educated and formed in their faith throughout their years here. As we have both grown old together, Bud has recognized that he doesn't have the stamina necessary to continue to serve us as he would like to so we have worked closely together as he planned for his retirement; it is well-deserved.



I have also worked closely with the Archdiocesan Office of Catholic Education and Phil Hintze, the chairman of our school's Board of Limited Jurisdiction who, as chair of this Board was also the chair of the Search Committee that started last October to prepare a nationwide solicitation for a new principal. We received a dozen applications – one from as far away as California – and after Bernadette Dougherty, the assistant superintendent for elementary schools in the Archdiocese vetted them, the Search Committee interviewed the four best candidates, selecting the top two from that group. Then, a committee of school teachers and staff interviewed these two and both the Search Committee and the school committee offered me their unanimous recommendation: Adria Crowley, one of our own teachers!



Adria has taught in our school for five years, first as technology teacher and most recently as a kindergarten teacher. Like Bud, who first taught our eighth grade here for three years before becoming our principal, Adria has the clear advantage of being familiar with our school and all of the wonderful ways in which it already educates and forms our children in a warm, friendly community. And like Bud did before he was hired as our principal, Adria has already demonstrated strong administrative leadership in our school. She co-chaired our school's Blue Ribbon Committee, leading us to receive the prestigious Blue Ribbon of Excellence Award in 2020. She was a member of our school's COVID-19 Task Force that helped us to successfully navigate through the pandemic. And, she is currently the co-chair of our Middle States Reaccreditation Team.

We are confident Adria will be committed to preserving both our strong Catholic identity and our sense of community as we continue to evolve and enhance the quality of education at our school. Please join me in congratulating Adria and welcoming her as our new principal. And, I'm sure you'll join me in thanking Bud for his 20 years of dedicated service to our school community; well done, Bud!

During our last after school Youth Group, we had slushies, soccer/basketball, and learned about the Parable of the Prodigal Son. Who do you need to forgive in your life?

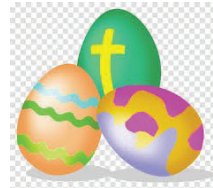
