From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers

SUMMER PROJECTS and STAFFING UPDATES

It's hard to believe that summer is coming to an end; I hope you've enjoyed some time for rest and relaxation! As we do every summer, we have undertaken a number of projects throughout our parish facilities throughout the summer. One was planned, the other was quite unexpected! The beautiful terrazzo floor in our church needs to be polished every eight to ten years and it has been just ten years since this was last done. So, we contracted with John Trinh (who had polished the floor ten years ago) in February to make sure he would be available during the summer, when there would be fewer interruptions to this time and labor intensive work. He started to work right after the school year ended in June and completed it this past week. I hope you will agree that it looks spectacular!436,800

It's an expensive project - \$35,000 – but when spread over ten years, it's a good deal and returns our church floor to its original splendor. Please consider making an increased donation to your parish to help us pay for this work.



The other major project was completely unexpected. As I informed everyone via Flocknote, Option C (for our school families) and email (for our PREP families) last May, our parish center suffered a serious flood during the overnight of 28 – 29 April after AQUA PA connected it to the new water main that had been installed on Midland Avenue; 60,000 gallons of water flowed into the gym, the locker rooms, Youth Ministry Office, mechanical room and the refuse and utility closets. The gym floor had to be removed and replaced (at a cost of \$150,000) and the lower two feet of walling had be cut out and replaced in all of the affected rooms (at a cost of \$20,000). Fortunately, insurance will cover these costs. But, with the unanimous endorsement of our school's Board of Limited Jurisdiction, we also decided to repaint the gym; you will recall that it was a drab grey and the paint on the ceiling was beginning to chip in several large areas. Due to the size and complexity of this project, it cost \$66,000. The BLJ agreed to pay half of this expense from its Annual Fund; thanks to everyone who has so generously contributed to this Fund. The parish will cover the other half so again I ask you to consider making an increased donation to your parish to help us pay for this work. The gym looks great and the new floor will be kind to those who play on it for years to come due to its new, better bounce feature!



Additionally, all of the hard surface floors in our school were stripped and waxed. This is done every summer to prepare for another busy school year; the cost for this work is \$7,800. We have 415 signed up in our school this year; a very strong enrollment indeed!

Speaking of school, there have been a number of changes in our staff. As you have probably already learned, Bud Tosti, our outstanding school principal for 17 years, retired in June and Adria Crowley, who had been teaching in our school for five years, first as technology teacher and then as a kindergarten teacher, has succeeded Bud as our principal. And, with the departure of Chrissy O'Sullivan, Mary De-Petris and Maryanne Fitzpatrick, we have hired Catherine Ryan as our new kindergarten teacher, Bridget Julrano and Susan Gardner as our new second grade teachers and Abby Miller as our new STEM teacher. All of these new teachers have come highly recommended and we're looking forward to their contributing well to our already-excellent teaching staff.

You have probably already learned that Greg Schmidt, our school custodian, had a serious medical incident last June leaving him with several challenges. He is recovering and has been very grateful for your prayers. Please continue to pray for him for a full recovery. In the meantime, we've engaged a company to provide us with custodial services.

And Chris Plasha, who has been our facilities manager for the past eight years, has decided to seek employment closer to his new home in the Poconos. He had the opportunity to purchase a house there last winter but has found the commute to be a challenge. We have benefited greatly from his extensive background and many talents and wish him well as he settles into his new home and seeks employment nearby. We are in the process of engaging a facility manager in his place.

Yes, it's been a very busy summer and we're ready for another exciting fall as all of our parish activities resume!
