From the desk of Monsignor Brouwers

CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL

“As often as you did it for one of my least brothers, you did it for me” (Mt 25:40). For the past 65 years, *Catholic Charities Appeal* has provided assistance for over 12 million people throughout the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. As you can well imagine, this assistance is particularly important at this time while we all face the effects of ongoing inflation. The needy are particularly affected as they struggle to feed their families, care for their aging parents and grandparents and educate their children with special needs in a Catholic environment. Your contribution helps to fund over 100 Catholic Social Services and Nutritional Development organizations and programs. The *Catholic Charities Appeal* supports agencies in the five counties of the archdiocese, from adoption services to community food programs to senior adult services to schools and homes for people who are visually or hearing impaired or developmentally disabled.

Last year, 640,000 men, women and children received assistance from these services. Almost 2 million meals were served through 50 food cupboards and more than 5,800 senior citizens were served in Senior Centers and parish programs throughout the archdiocese. Hundreds of children in our archdiocesan-run schools of special education receive tuition assistance and support. Almost 4,000 women and men received pregnancy and parenting support and over 8,400 parents received baby care items.

Your annual commitment to this important work assures that the *Catholic Charities Appeal* can continue to provide much-needed assistance for men, women and children throughout the archdiocese. As followers of Christ, we are called to be our Lord’s heart and hands in loving care for those in the greatest need and, in their name, I thank you!

Like all households in our parish and, indeed, throughout the archdiocese, you should have recently received a packet with a letter from Archbishop Nelson Pérez inviting you to participate in the annual *Catholic Charities Appeal* with a sacrificial gift. The theme for this year’s appeal is “Giving Hope to All,” and the goal is \$12.5 million. Aware of God’s love for you, we are asking you to embrace those with special needs.
