Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On October 22, we will join Catholics worldwide to observe World Mission Sunday by celebrating the love of the Lord and help bring the Good news to all corners of the Earth.


Middle School Youth Group will meet 2:45-4:00pm on Tuesday, October 17th and 24th.
